Job Summary

The Social Mobilizer is responsible for mobilizing communities, identifying and registering beneficiaries, facilitating community meetings, supporting project implementation, ensuring community participation, and maintaining effective coordination with local stakeholders to achieve project objectives.

Authority Assigned

- Conduct community mobilization activities in assigned areas.
- Verify beneficiary information and recommend eligible households.
- Coordinate with village committees and community representatives.
- Organize community meetings and awareness sessions.
- Submit field reports and project documentation to the supervisor.
- Report field challenges, complaints, and safeguarding concerns promptly.
